Principal's Report	<p>Mr. Kalberlah spoke to Mrs. Hudson (Auburn Principal) in response to students' survey - Auburn students' population is not receptive to the idea of traveling between schools and sharing courses or teachers. Only 30% of students surveyed showed any interest for the idea.</p> <p>Green Room will turn into a specific place for the TAP program.
